The AllTrain consortium would like to inform you about the 2nd AllTrain Workshop (“All-Hazard-Guide for Transport Infrastructure”) (www.alltrain-project.eu) in Vienna, Austria.

THE PROJECT

The project AllTrain – being funded by the European Commission DG General Home Affairs under the *Prevention, Preparedness and Consequence Management of Terrorism and other Security-related Risks* Program (CIPS) - aims to contribute to the development of a secure, effective and functional transport network across Europe by identifying and assessing all possible threats to transport infrastructures. By considering road and rail structures, the project accounts for the interconnectiveness of transport across Europe. Furthermore, the final assessment of transport infrastructure regarding various threats will be compiled into a guide for owners and operators of transport networks in order to enable them to obtain information on which of their infrastructures might potentially be susceptible to a specific threat and which specific threat might potentially have the largest impact on their structures.
